SPRING MOUNTAIN RANCH

Spring Mountain Ranch, a 520 acre oasis situated at the base of the magnificent Wilson Cliffs, was developed into a combination working ranch and luxurious retreat by a string of owners. The site has a long and varied history. By the mid-1830s a campsite had been established along the creek that runs through the ranch. The spring-fed stream and the grassy meadows formed a welcome oasis for travelers who used this alternate Spanish Trail route through Cottonwood Valley. This use of the site by pack and wagon trains continued until their replacement by the railroad in 1905. This remote trail was also used extensively by outlaws involved in Indian slave trading, horse stealing, and raids upon passing caravans. In 1840, a group of American mountain men and the Ute Indians conducted a famous raid on the Mexican Ranchos in California. Mountaineer Bill Williams, a member of the raiding party, brought his band of horses through Red Rock Canyon where he stayed while the horses recovered from the hard trip across the desert. Apparently he made other visits to the area, and for many years afterwards the site of Spring Mountain Ranch was known as the Bill Williams Ranch. Miners from the nearby Potosi lead mines farmed at the site in 1861, but abandoned the operation soon afterwards at the outbreak of the Civil War. in 1876 former Fort Mojave-based Sergeant James B. Wilcon and his partner, George Anderson, filed on the property, which they named Sand Stone Ranch. Wilson remained until his death in 1906, while Anderson left in the early 1880s, never to return. Anderson left his two half-Paiute boys for Wilson to raise. The two boys, Jim Wilson Jr. and Tweed, his half brother, inherited the ranch in 1906 after Jim Wilson, Sr. died. They operated the ranch together for many years. After mortgaging it in 1919, they were unable to pay off the debt. But in 1929 the ranch was acquired by a family friend, Willard George, who gave the two men a life estate to the old cabins. This privilege ended in 1959 with the death of Tweed. There is a small family plot on the ranch where three generations of Wilson men were buried.

Willard George was a prominent furrier in Hollywood at the time of this takeover. He attempted to raise chinchillas on the ranch in addition to the cattle operation. in 1944, the ranch was leased to Chester Lauck, the "Lum" of the "Lum" and Abner" radio show. Later, Lauck picked up his option to buy the property and began construction of the main ranch house. Lauck's "Bar Nothing Ranch" was a vacation retreat for his family. He opened a boys camp on the property and continued the cattle operation. Lauck also built a large reservoir for irrigation and installed a water poured generating system dubbed "Boulder Dam, Jr."

In 1955 Lauck sold the ranch to Vera Krupp, wife of German munitions industrialist Alfred Krupp von Bohlen and Halbach. She added the swimming pool and west wing to the main house and expanded the cattle operation. The ranch was renamed the Spring Mountain Ranch and was Mrs. Krupp's principal residence until 1967. That year Mrs. Krupp sold the ranch to Hughes Tool Company, now Howard Hughes Corporation. Little use was made of the ranch except by Hughes president Robert Maheu. After he left the company in 1969, the house was maintained in caretaker status. In 1972 two Southern California businessmen, Fletcher Jones and William Murphy, purchased the property as a real estate speculation. Public objections to the proposed townhouse/condominium development resulted in an offer to sell the property to the Nevada Division of State Parks. This transaction was completed in the spring of 1974.

HOW THEATRE CAME TO THE RANCH

presenting cultural arts events at the Spring Mnt Ranch State Park in the upper meadow just below the Ranch House. It was the policy of Junior League at the time to turn over viable projects to a community led organizations after 2-3 years. The Junior League dubbed the season in 1979 'Super Summer 79' & the State Cultural Arts Committee took the reins from the Junior League. The State Cultural Arts Board was officially formed in 1980. Shows continued outdoors until 1987 when Nevada Gov. Richard Bryan was invited by the Board to break ground on the performance pavilion made possible through the fundraising efforts of the Board. In 2015 SST welcomed it's one millionth patron to see performances at the Ranch.

In 1976 the Las Vegas Junior League started a State Park Project, managed by their cultural arts committee. They started The pavilion was rededicated as the Boman Pavilion in 2017 after Super Summer Theatres' Thanks A Million Campaign provided funds for many of the capital improvements which enhance performances you see today. It is the Board of Super Summer Theatre's great privilege and hope that their continued work brings awareness to the beautiful natural surrounds of the park and shows why it should be preserved for years to come. The Spring Mnt Ranch State Park has many useful culturally diverse purposes. The Super Summer Theatre Board will be pleased to present performing arts here `under the stars' for as long as the people of Southern Nevada want to attend performances at the Ranch.






