SOUND ENGINEER / AUDIO HOD (A1)

Duties:

A1 will assists designer with mixing of rehearsals.

A1 will be responsible for mixing the performances during the show run

A1 will be responsible for all cabling and patching laid out in the sound design.

A1 will be responsible for maintenance and care of technical gear, including repairs needed or sending out equipment.

A1 will monitor mixes when needed to troubleshoot and to ensure proper working order during rehearsals and shows. This includes checking placement, cabling, and voicing of each monitor mix every day.

A1 will be responsible for proper placement of microphones on musicians and will guide the RF technician in proper placement and care of the wireless mics on actors.

A1 will be responsible for preshow line check of each and every input and output channel each rehearsal and performance day. This includes master mix, front fills, surrounds, lip fills, monitor mixes and any other mixes in the sound design.

A1 will communicate any and all issues with the mix or design to Sound Designer.

A1 will be responsible for checking software and hardware are communicating properly each rehearsal and show day.

A1 will lead the audio team in set up and strike of all the sound related gear, including microphones, speakers, computers, sound consoles, cables, etc. for each rehearsal or show.

A1 will go through Sound Designers, Stage Managers, and Director's notes or checklists before each performance. These may include important changes or adjustments to the design, cue changes, systems and microphone checks.

A1 will be the main point of contact for any audio rental gear.

A1 will maintain an inventory of gear including equipment that is damaged and needs to be repaired or replaced.

A1 must communicate any gear needs immediately to prevent further issues.

A1 will be responsible for troubleshooting and lead crew in resolution to audio issues.

A1 will maintains all backup files for the FOH console.
