Super Summer Theatre has come a long way since the curtain first went up in 1976 with a run of Shakespeare plays performed by actors who doubled as ticket agents and passed the microphone to one another. Since then, more than 1.2 Million patrons have thrown down a blanket, shared a picnic dinner with friends, and enjoyed great theatre under the stars.

Following You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown, which will be presented with Hynes-Sight Entertainment, the SUPER SUMMER 2021 Season continues in August with VIVA Las POPera. Presented with Vegas City Opera, this concert features hits from Elvis, Frank Sinatra, Queen, Michael Bublé, Andre Bocelli, Sara Brightman, Phantom of the Opera and more. The SUPER SUMMER 2021 Season concludes in September with *Smokey Joe's Café*. Presented with PS Productions and featuring nearly 40 of the greatest songs ever recorded, *Smokey Joe's Café* isn't just great pop music – it's compelling musical theatre.

Patrons returning to the Meadow this summer will get an extra special treat as the Concession Stand is getting a facelift before the SUPER SUMMER 2021 Season opens.
